It is for information of all concerned that the commission have decided to use a common OMR Answer sheet for all MCQ type tests in which responses/answers to 200 questions can be made by darkening the bubbles. The candidates are required to darken only the required number of bubbles not exceeding the total number of questions in the Question booklet. The remaining bubbles may be left blank.

For example- A candidate appearing for General Studies Paper-I in OCS, 2016 Preliminary examination, shall have to answer/darken maximum up to Serial No. 100 (from Sl. No 1 to 100) in the OMR Answer Sheet since the test booklet in Paper-I contains 100 questions. The remaining bubbles i.e from Sl. No 101 to 200 may be kept blank as evaluation of these bubbles will not be done. In case of doubt, the helpline No. 0671-2305611/2304141 may be contacted.

A specimen copy of the Answer Sheet is appended at ANNEXURE-A.

Other particulars on the Answer Sheet i.e. Name of the Exam, Subject, Date of examination, His/her Roll No etc. are to be filled up/darkened by the candidate before answering the questions.

INSTRUCTIONS

- The answer sheet contains 200 slots having 4 (four) ovals each. However, depending upon the number of questions in the Test Booklet, the candidates have to darken the required number of spaces and others may be left blank. - Use Blue / Black ball point pen only to fill the answer sheet.
